Martin Luther King, Jr. Elementary students are participating in the Title I Part A Program. As a parent of a child who receives Title I services in our school, parents have the right to give input about how the school district budgets and spends its Title I Parental Involvement money. Over the last few months, our school held various meetings with parents to include our Annual Title I meeting. In the meetings, we discussed the following:

1. Parents liked the resources that were made available for them last year and requested more resources for this year on how to help their child at home.
2. Parents would like to have a series of workshops to help their child in the areas of math and reading.
